IFWG Publishing Australia is an Australian-owned, managed, small independent press, specializing in speculative fiction titles. We are proud to release the first title of an elite dark fantasy/horror series, "Dark Phases": *Peripheral Visions: The Collected Ghost Stories*, by Robert Hood.

Peripheral Visions is available in cloth bound and trade paperback formats. The former is in a single-volume form, over 800 pages in length. The TPB form is published in two volumes, over 400 pages in each. The Cloth Bound version exclusively contains 7 full-page illustrations by the multi-Archibald Prize finalist, Nick Stathopoulos. The Dark Phases series imprint only applies to the cloth bound editions.

Robert Hood is an internationally recognised author of speculative fiction, especially among readers of dark fantasy and horror. His ghost stories are notably respected, and *Peripheral Visions* collects every single short fiction ghost story he has ever published, spanning 30 years, plus 3 original pieces.

We are extremely proud of this title, and SF Signal, This Is Horror, Tangent Online, and Ellen Datlow (Tor Books), have already sought review copies. We believe you will find the title, especially the cloth bound edition, magnificent.

Adjunct to this letter of introduction is a promotion brochure that provides more detail on the title and Robert Hood.

Note that in our direct sales effort of these books, the cloth bound version sold considerably more than expected, due to its significant aesthetic value.
